Learning Continues at Home!



Letter Knowledge (knowing that letters are different from each other, knowing letter names and sounds, recognizing letters everywhere)

Go on a shape hunt! Letters are shapes that your child will need to recognize to learn to read, so recognizing basic shapes now will get him/her on the right track! Help your child look for circles, triangles and squares around your home. Make a game of it!

Continue the Fun...

Spaghetti Play

This is a one-of-a-kind sensory experience for your child, and a great way to explore color. You will need uncooked spaghetti, water, a pot, food coloring, and a towel (for mess-containing purposes only). Overcook the spaghetti by 3 minutes more than suggested on the packaging. Drain the water and rinse the spaghetti under cold water. Lay it out on a tray as it cools and be sure to shake it apart regularly, separating the strands. Put a portion of the spaghetti into a plastic baggie, add two or three drops of food coloring, and smoosh them around together. Shake apart the spaghetti as often as needed and wait 24 hours for the colouring to set inside the pasta. Then you're ready to play!


