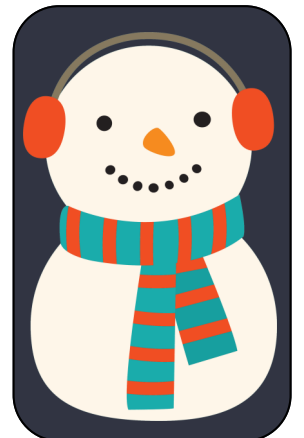
# Action Rhymes and Fingerplays
