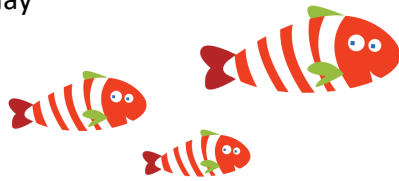


# Songs

(tune: "Wheels on the Bus")

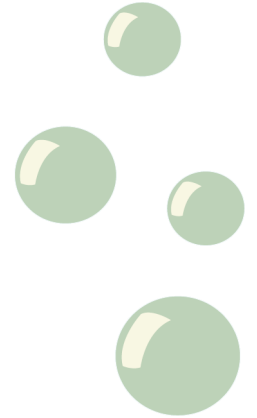
The waves on the sea go up and down

That's what it's all about

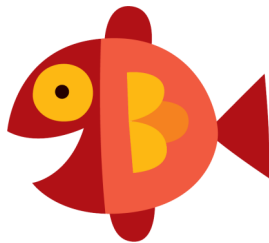

## This week's early literacy practice: SING

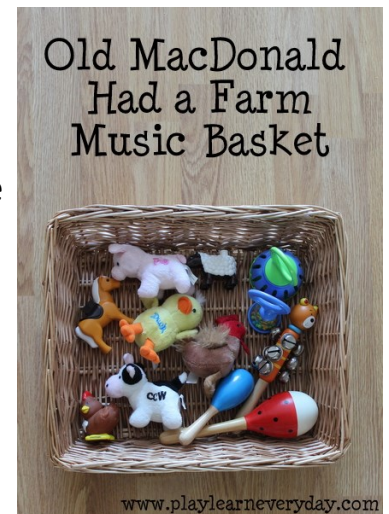

## Continue the Fun...

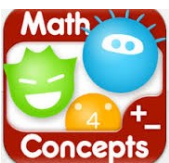
### Song Baskets (via [playlearneveryday.com](http://playlearneveryday.com))
