(tune: "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star")

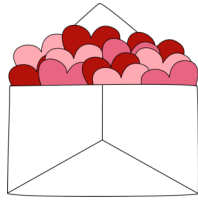
It's a happy, happy day

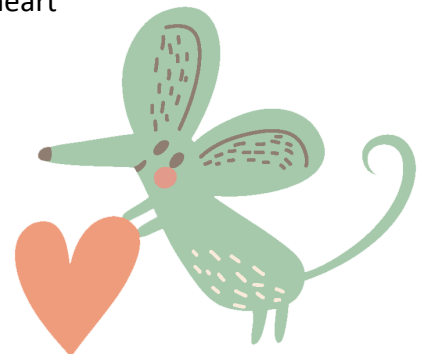
# Action Rhymes and Fingerplays

## Open, Shut Them

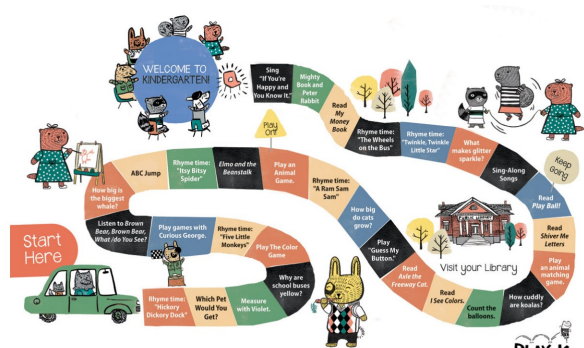
Open, shut them
