(tune: "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star")

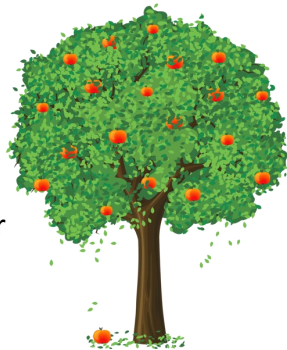
It's a happy, happy day

## Five Little Cookies

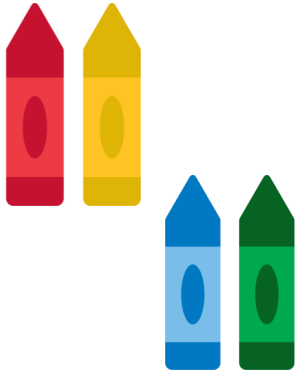
Five little cookies, with frosting galore
