














Opening (Closing) Song: Happy Day

(*tune: Row, Row, Row Your Boat*) Snowflakes falling down, Falling to the ground. Big, white, fluffy flakes That do not make a sound.


One Pink Valentine

Make a heart close to the ground.


Make it small.

Early Literacy Skill: Print Motivation (being interested in and enjoying books) Positive experiences with books are so important for your child, but there are not hard and fast rules to follow! Any amount of time, any book about any topic - it all encourages a love of reading in your child.

Continue the Fun...



Make a personalized Flap Book for your child.

Create a book cover with two pieces of cardboard connected with duct tape hinges. Put a strip of Velcro on the inside of the "book." Attach the other piece of Velcro to a picture card. Change the picture card every day. Your child can practice opening the book and seeing the new picture. Talk about the picture with your child.

Picture Cards: Cut out pictures of familiar objects from magazines. Glue them to index cards and cover with contact paper. Keep the cards in a box and let your child play with the cards. Talk about the cards as he plays with them. Ask him to point to certain cards or find the objects in the house.
