Action Rhymes and Fingerplays

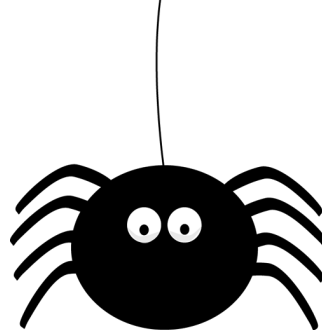
Open, Shut Them

But do not let them in, in, in!

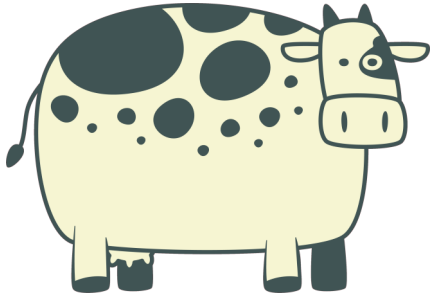


Itsy Bitsy Spider

Learning Continues at Home



Phonological awareness (recognizing that letters are different from each other, have names, and represent sounds)

No book handy? When you play with your child with stuffed animals or other animal toys, encourage him or her to make the sounds of animals. When you go for a walk or are talking with your child, talk about animals and the sounds they make. Encourage your child to repeat them.

Water "Painting"

This simple art activity will develop your child's fine motor skills (small movements — such as picking up small objects or holding a spoon). Show your child how to dip a paintbrush in a bowl of water and "paint" walls, benches, or other outdoor objects - or colored construction paper if it's cold outside! Talk about why the painting eventually disappears.
