To make a discovery basket for your baby or toddler, all you need is a container and some interesting things to go inside. No need to buy a special basket - use a laundry basket, picnic hamper, shopping bag, or cardboard box. Place theme-based, child-safe items from your home inside the basket, and talk to your child about the names of each item and what they all have in common. Build baskets based on different colors, senses, textures, foods, etc. Each time you change what's inside, show your child how exciting it is to see the new things!

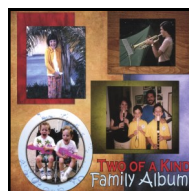

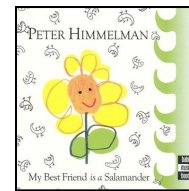
