Opening (Closing) Song: Happy Day

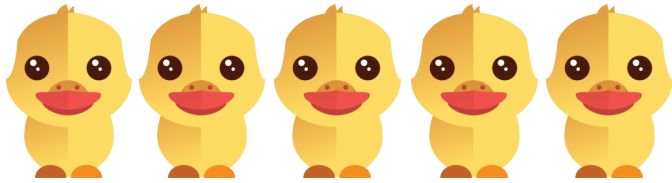
(tune: Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star)

Open, Shut Them

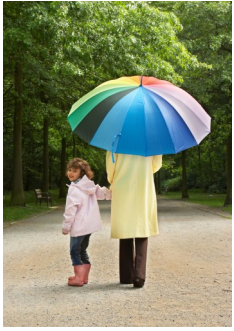
Open, shut them

Learning Continues at Home



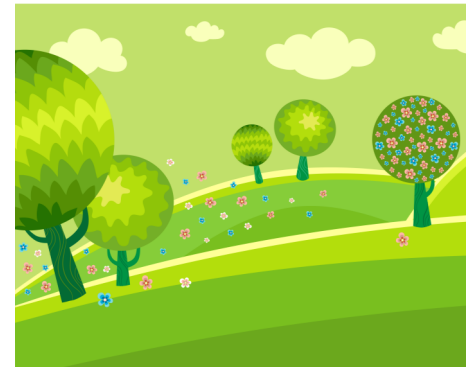
Vocabulary (knowing the names of things and understanding feelings and concepts)
