

Craft: Make a Kite Day headband!



Print the attached pdf onto cardstock paper and instruct each child to color the kites.

Then, cut out each strip of kites and attach them together with tape to make a long strip.

Wrap the strip around the child's head and tape according to head size. Cut off the remaining part of the strip and then tape down that end.

At the back of the head, use tape to attach a streamer to the inside of the headband and then fold the streamer over the top of the band. Use tape to attach the streamer to the outside of the headband as well.

Tie strips of other colors to the main streamer to make it look like the tail of a kite.

Wear the headband when you meet Will Hillenbrand!
