

(tune: "Twinkle, Twinkle, Little Star")



Let's tap our names!






If You Want to Hear a Story

Little Caterpillar


There was a little caterpillar crawling all about (walk with fingers on arm)

Little friends of PURPLE, fly in too - the garden is waiting for a color like you


Hello ORANGE, we've waited so long - fly right in, where you belong

Right up to your chin, chin, chin


Open wide, your little mouth...


